





Report on Faculty Development Program

Outcome Based Education

Organised by Internal Quality Assurance Cell

On 03/02/2024, IQAC organised a Faculty Development Program on OBE for the staff members of our college. The program started at 10.30 AM with Qirath recited by Mrs. Rahiya Head, Department of Urdu. It was followed by welcome address by Dr, Freda Gnanselvam, Principal of the college. Dr. Mohammed Shafiullah, Assistant Professor, Department of Chemistry, C. Abdul Hakeem College, Melvisharam, an expert in this field was the chief guest. Outcome-Based Education (OBE) is a student-centred approach to teaching and learning that focuses on achieving specific learning outcomes.

Dr. Mohammed Shafiullah began the session by emphasizing the importance of OBE in today's education system. He explained that traditional education often focuses on inputs, such as the number of hours spent in the classroom or the content covered in the syllabus, rather than on the actual learning outcomes. OBE, on the other hand, shifts the focus to the desired outcomes of education, ensuring that students acquire the necessary knowledge, skills, and competencies.

During the seminar, Dr. Mohammed Shafiullah discussed the key principles of OBE, which include defining clear and measurable learning outcomes, aligning teaching strategies and assessments with these outcomes, and continuously evaluating and improving the effectiveness of the educational program. He also highlighted the role of teachers as facilitators in the OBE approach, guiding students towards achieving the desired outcomes.

Dr. Mohammed Shafiullah shared various examples and case studies to illustrate the implementation of OBE in different educational settings. He discussed how OBE can enhance student engagement and motivation, as students become more aware of what they are expected to learn and how they can achieve it. He also emphasized that OBE can lead to more meaningful and lifelong learning, as it focuses on the development of transferable skills that are applicable in real-world contexts.

The session further examined the challenges and potential solutions for implementing OBE in educational institutions. Dr. Mohammed Shafiullah discussed the need for faculty development programs to train and support teachers in adopting OBE practices. He also

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highlighted the importance of creating a conducive learning environment that encourages active student participation and feedback.

Overall, the seminar on OBE conducted by Dr. Mohammed Shafiullah was well-received and highly informative. Participants gained a deeper understanding of the principles and benefits of OBE, and they were encouraged to explore its implementation in their respective classrooms.

After lunch break the teachers were given time to work on with their subjects being taught this semester and what methodology was adopted in class room. Four staff members, Mrs. Salma Farheen, Head Department of Business Administration, Mrs, Shamila Sultana, Head Department of Commerce CA, Dr. Punithavathy, Head Department of Biotechnology, Mrs. Gowsiya Assistant Professor, Department of Nutrition presented their methodology which proved that the teachers understood the concept of OBE. The event was a valuable learning opportunity for faculty members, helping them enhance their teaching practices and contribute to the overall improvement of the education system.


