Throughout the year, we have focused on strengthening our core values, enhancing operational efficiency, and fostering an environment that encourages learning, collaboration, and impact. Despite challenges, our dedicated team has continued to drive meaningful change, ensuring that we remain at the forefront of our industry. The activities of the various departments are as follows:

**Department of English**

The PG & Research Department of English Inaugurated English Literary Association (ELA) on 11<sup>th</sup> July 2024. Dr. S.
